Admissions to the MOT degree program requires a baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution, as well as the completion of the following prerequisites:

- Your application will not be considered for admissions until **7** out of the **10 required** prerequisite courses are completed, **statistics is considered optional**. USAHS allows for three courses to be in progress with completion of the courses expected before the applicable term start.
- Lab components for the Physical Science courses below are highly recommended, but not required.

1 course - Minimum of 3 semester credits/4.5 quarter credits of Biology – must be Human Based Biology ; knowledge of human body, structure and function (Exercise Physiology can be used as a substitute; Introductory courses acceptable)					
2 courses - Minimum of 6 semester credits/9 quarter credits of General or Upper Level Human Anatomy & Physiology (Knowledge of human body, structure and function)					
1 course Minimum of 3 semester credits/4.5 quarter credits of Human Growth and Development over Lifespan (Lifespan development course including motor and psychosocial development from birth to end of life)					
4 courses -Minimum of 12 semester credits/18 quarter credits of Social Sciences (Any combination of Psychology, Sociology, Sociocultural/Socioeconomic, Anthropology, Human Behavior and Development, Public Health, Humanities (must show human relationships), Ethnicity or Gender Studies courses can be used toward this requirement)					
1 course - Minimum of 1 semester credit/1.5 quarter credits of Medical Terminology					
1 course -Optional: 3 semester credit/4.5 quarter credits of Statistics
