What do I do if I am not cleared to enter campus?

Contact

Consult

If you are not feeling well or have new or unexplained COVID-19 related symptoms that began in the last 10 days, please consult your health care provider for guidance.

Campus Reentry

Positive diagnosis: If confirmed/presumed positive for COVID-19 you may return to campus after at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared, AND you have improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); AND at least 24 hours of no fever without the use of fever-reducing medication AND received clearance to reenter campus by a member of the USAHS Reentry Team.

Exposed to COVID-19: You are required to quarantine for 10 days from the date of last contact, or 7 days after receiving negative test result (test must occur day 5 or later) AND receive clearance to reenter campus by a member of the USAHS Reentry Team. Exceptions to quarantine are if individual is currently asymptomatic AND either (a) has been fully vaccinated for at least 2 weeks (FDA authorized vaccine only), or (b) has had COVID-19 within the last 3 months.
