Two-Step PPD or QuantiFERON Gold/IGRA/T-Spot Form

Please obtain one of the following tests:

the **two-step PPD** or the **QuantiFERON Gold/IGRA/T-Spot** test. It is not necessary to do both.

Baseline Testing: Two-Step PPD Test per CDC Guidelines

Two-step testing with the tuberculosis (TB) skin test should be used as a baseline or for initial testing. Occasionally, the first TB test displays an inaccurate result. To best ensure accuracy, USAHS requires students to receive a second TB test.

To meet USAHS health policy requirements, students must obtain the second TB test 1-3 weeks after receiving the results from the first TB test.

QuantiFERON Gold/IGRA/T-Spot Testing Guidelines

QuantiFERON Gold/IGRA/T-Spot testing is used to measure immune reaction to *M. tuberculosis* per CDC guidelines. It's a one-time test that involves a blood draw. The results are available in 1-3 business days.
