Requirements

Meet all admissions requirements:

- A bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
- GRE taken within the past 5 years*
- All program prerequisites completed within the past 5 years (recommended)*



Documentation

Gather the documents you need to apply:

- Transcripts
- Plan for completing pending prerequisites
- Resume



Submission

Complete the Supplemental Form on the USAHS website.



PT and SLP Applicants

PT and SLP applicants must apply through the **Common Application System**.

Create a profile, upload your documents, and respond to the essay prompt. Then submit your application for verification:

PT: [PTCAS](#). GRE code: 2209

SLP: [CSDCAS](#). GRE code: 2300

OT Applicants

OT students have 2 options:

1. You may apply through the Common Application System: [OTCAS](#). GRE code: 7352. Create a profile, upload your documents, and respond to the essay prompt. Then submit your application for verification.

2. You may also apply through USAHS's [free online application](#). GRE code: 5325. In that case, you must also submit a short statement of purpose.

! Application Limitations:

Please complete your application for only one program, one campus, and one start date. When your application is in "verified" status, an enrollment advisor will be in touch to schedule an application review appointment by phone.
