What is the CICP student worker program and the new Healthcare Simulation Student Certificate?

We are excited to launch a new CICP student worker program. We are currently accepting students who are interested gaining experience in healthcare simulation and supportive functions of the CICP open lab. As part of our new Healthcare Simulation Student Certificate Program, students that work at least 50 hours per term and meets certain objectives, will receive a digital badge certificate that can be placed on their professional resume or shared on their social media platforms.

What are the qualifications?

Requirements for employment:

- The successful candidate must have an overall GPA of 3.0 or better on all coursework completed and be currently enrolled in a graduate level degree program.
- Individuals should be in good standing with the University and at least in the second term of study (exceptions may apply)
- Must be organized and capable of solving issues, responding to general questions and responding to routine requests for information.
- Be able to work independently, as well as in a team environment, and demonstrate an understanding of the academic and professional experiences of students.
- Must be able to prioritize tasks and manage multiple projects with minimal supervision
- The Student Worker should plan to commit approximately 10 hours per week to this position.

What are the essential duties for this position?

- Set-up, breakdown, and supervision of CICP open lab
- Maintain and organize the CICP spaces
- Collaborate with CICP staff to support scheduled simulations and skills practice sessions
- Assist with training of standardized patients (SP), as well as participate as a SP when needed
- Communicate with faculty, staff, and students in a professional manner
