What do I do if I am not cleared to enter campus?

Contact

Confidentially notify <u>reentry@usa.edu</u> AND await for further instructions, Students contact your Academic Program Director, Faculty and Staff contact your supervisor and local campus HR Partner.

Consult

If you are not feeling well or have new or unexplained COVID-19-related symptoms that began in the last 5 days, please consult your health care provider for guidance.

Campus Reentry

Positive diagnosis: If confirmed/presumed positive for COVID-19 you may return to campus after at least 5 days have passed since symptoms first appeared , AND you have improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath), AND at least 24 hours of no fever without the use of fever-reducing medication, AND received clearance to reenter campus by a member of the USAHS Reentry Team.

Exposed to COVID-19: You are required to quarantine for 5 days from the date of last contact AND receive clearance to reenter campus by a member of the USAHS Reentry Team. Exceptions to quarantine are if individual currently has no symptoms AND either (a) has been fully vaccinated for at least 2 weeks, but no longer than 5 months, or (b) has received a COVID-19 booster, or (c) has had COVID-19 within the last 3 months.
